Thank you for continuing to support our parish food bank collection. Our Food Bank Collection deliveries in 2014 as of March 31st is 666 lbs, which has been brought to Winnipeg Harvest and soup kitchens. Our April deliveries are down slightly. 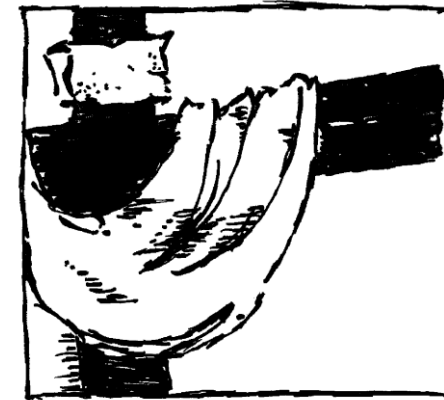
