We had record low donations for January at 102 lbs; followed by new record highs for the months of February & March. Our St. Theresa Food Bank Collection deliveries in 2013 as of March 31st is 672 lbs brought to Winnipeg Harvest vs. 743 lbs as of March 31st last year. Our 1st week April deliveries were down. Just because Lent has ended should not reduce our commitments to the poor and needy. Please remember the poor in prayer + tin for the bin. Keep up the good work!

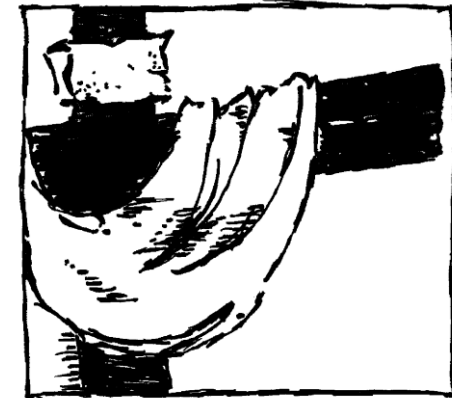
