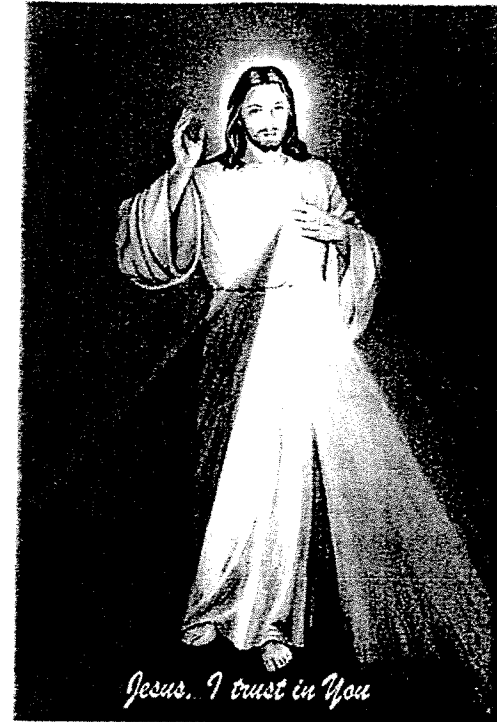

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY – APRIL 8, 2018



VENERATION OF THE SACRED IMAGE on the Feast of Divine Mercy

February 22, 1931 Our Lord appeared to St Faustina: I saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in the gesture of blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From beneath the garment, slightly drawn aside at the breast, there were emanating two large rays, one red, the other pale. Jesus said to me "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: **Jesus, I trust in You.**" (Diary 47)

I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy. I want this image...to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter. I desire that priests proclaim this great mercy of Mine towards souls of sinners. Let the sinner not be afraid to approach Me. (Diary 49/50)

These were the events that cost the parish money to run: turkey fundraiser, Spring Fling dance, Little BIGfundraiser and Fall Dinner/Dance. It appears that we only made \$300 for our fundraising efforts. That is NOT true. Some fundraising monies were donated back to the parish and so were recorded as income not shown as offsetting the Fundraising Expense. We have \$5,500 worth of prizes for future fundraising events from the Little BIGFundraiser!!!

Help me, O Lord, that my ears may be merciful, so that I may give heed to my neighbours' needs and not be indifferent to their pains and moanings.

Help me, O Lord, that my tongue may be merciful, so that I should never speak negatively of my neighbour, but have a word of comfort and forgiveness for all.

Help me, O Lord, that my hands may be merciful and filled with good deeds, so that I may do only good to my neighbours and take upon myself the most difficult and toilsome tasks.

Help me, O Lord, that my feet may be merciful, so that I may hurry to assist my neighbour, overcoming my own fatigue and weariness (...)

Help me, O Lord, that my heart may be merciful so that I myself may feel all the sufferings of my neighbour. (...)
