I urge everyone to be generous.

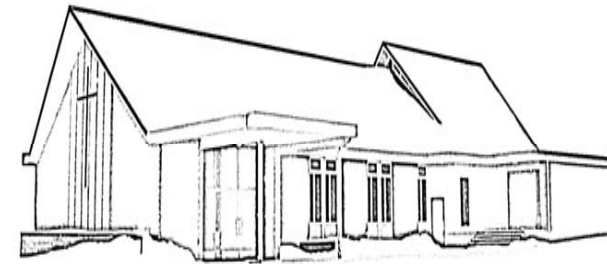
